This 6 Days Nduvu Migration Safari Tanzania is designed for travelers who want to experience the Great Migration in the Nduvu and Southern Serengeti ecosystem. From December to March, large herds of wildebeest, zebras, and gazelles gather across Nduvu's open plains, creating excellent opportunities for wildlife photography, predator sightings, and calving season encounters.

The itinerary combines Tarangire National Park, Nduvu, the Serengeti ecosystem, and Ngorongoro Crater. Tarangire adds elephants and baobab landscapes, Nduvu offers migration herds and predators, while Ngorongoro Crater provides one of Tanzania's strongest Big Five safari experiences. With Serengeti Wild Tours, this 6 Days Nduvu Migration Safari in Tanzania gives you a focused, private, and well-balanced northern Tanzania safari.

## Itinerary

### Arrival in Arusha

#### Day 1

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge or hotel

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport or Arusha Airport, where your Serengeti Wild Tours representative will welcome you and transfer you to your hotel in Arusha. Depending on your arrival time, you may relax at the hotel or meet your guide for a short briefing about the 6 Days Ndutu Migration Safari Tanzania. Dinner and overnight will be in Arusha.

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## Day 2 **Arusha to Tarangire National Park**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire or Karatu lodge

After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park for your first wildlife experience. Tarangire is known for large elephant herds, baobab trees, seasonal swamps, and classic savannah landscapes. During the game drive, look for elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, buffalo, lions, and many bird species. Later, continue to your lodge or camp for dinner and overnight.

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## Day 3 **Tarangire to Ndotu Area**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ndotu tented camp or lodge

After breakfast, travel toward the Ndotu area in the Southern Serengeti ecosystem. The route passes through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and beautiful highland scenery before reaching the open Ndotu plains. During the migration season, this area can hold large herds of wildebeest, zebras, and gazelles. Enjoy an afternoon game drive while looking for migration herds, lions, cheetahs, hyenas, jackals, and other wildlife.

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## Day 4 **Full Day Ndotu Migration Safari**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ndotu tented camp or lodge

Spend a full day exploring Ndotu and the surrounding Southern Serengeti plains. Your guide will follow herd movement, predator activity, and recent sightings to select the best game drive areas. This is one of the best regions for calving season, large herds, cheetah sightings, lion activity, hyenas, and open-plains photography. The day gives you enough time to enjoy the rhythm of the Great Migration in Ndotu.

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## Day 5 **Ndotu Game Drive to Ngorongoro Area**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Enjoy another morning game drive in Ndotu for more chances to see migration herds and predator behavior. After lunch, continue toward the Ngorongoro highlands. The scenery changes from open plains to volcanic landscapes and green highland views. Arrive near Ngorongoro or Karatu for dinner

and overnight, ready for the crater safari the next morning.

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**Day 6** **Ngorongoro Crater Game Drive and Return to Arusha**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: No accommodation included

After early breakfast, descend into Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive on the crater floor. This wildlife-rich area offers strong chances to see lions, elephants, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, hyenas, and, with luck, black rhino. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater before ascending the crater wall and driving back to Arusha. This marks the end of your 6 Days Nduu Migration Safari Tanzania.

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## Frequently Asked Questions

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### **What is the best time for the 6 Days Ndotu Migration Safari Tanzania?**

The best time is usually from December to March, when the Great Migration herds gather in Ndotu and the Southern Serengeti ecosystem.

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### **Does this safari include Tarangire National Park?**

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### **Can I see calving season on this safari?**

Yes. The concentration of wildebeest, zebras, and young calves attracts lions, cheetahs, hyenas, jackals, and other predators.
