### Overview

This 5 Days Western Corridor Migration Safari Tanzania is designed for travelers who want to follow the Great Migration through the Western Serengeti and Grumeti River area. From around May to July, large herds of wildebeest and zebras move through the Western Corridor, creating exciting wildlife viewing opportunities around river systems, open plains, woodlands, and predator territories.

The safari combines Central Serengeti, the Western Corridor, the Grumeti River region, and Ngorongoro Crater. Central Serengeti offers excellent year-round wildlife and big cat sightings, while the Western Corridor provides a seasonal migration experience with dramatic landscapes and river-based wildlife. With Serengeti Wild Tours, this 5 Days Western Corridor Migration Safari in Tanzania is a focused private safari for travelers who want a short but rewarding Serengeti migration route.

- Visit the Grumeti River area, known for migration herds and crocodile-filled river habitats.

## Arusha to Central Serengeti

### Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti tented camp or lodge

After breakfast, drive toward Serengeti National Park through the Ngorongoro highlands and open plains. After entering the Serengeti, enjoy an en-route game drive in Central Serengeti, an area known for lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, gazelles, and hyenas. Arrive at your camp or lodge for dinner and overnight.

## Central Serengeti to Western Corridor and Grumeti River

### Day 3

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Western Serengeti tented camp or lodge

After breakfast, travel west toward the Western Corridor and Grumeti River area. The route offers game viewing through changing Serengeti habitats, including plains, river valleys, and woodland areas. During the migration season, wildebeest and zebra herds may move through this region as they follow seasonal grazing patterns. Enjoy game drives around the Western Corridor while looking for migration herds, crocodiles near river systems, lions, leopards, elephants, giraffes, buffalo, and plains wildlife.

## Western Serengeti Game Drive to Ngorongoro Area

### Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Enjoy a morning game drive in the Western Serengeti and Grumeti River region for another chance to see migration movement and resident wildlife. After lunch, begin the journey back across the Serengeti toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The day combines wildlife viewing with scenic changes from western plains and river valleys to the crater highlands. Arrive near Ngorongoro or Karatu for dinner and overnight.

## Ngorongoro Crater Game Drive and Return to Arusha

### Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: No accommodation included

After early breakfast, descend into Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive on the crater floor. This natural wildlife sanctuary offers strong chances to see lions, elephants, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, hyenas, and, with luck, black rhino. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater before ascending the crater wall and driving back to Arusha. This marks the end of your 5 Days Western Corridor Migration Safari Tanzania.
