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Overview

This 6 Days Western Corridor Great Migration Safari is designed for travelers who want to experience the Great Migration in the Western Serengeti and Grumeti River region, while also visiting Tarangire National Park and Ngorongoro Crater. From around May to July, wildebeest and zebra herds often move through the Western Corridor, creating exciting safari opportunities across open plains, woodlands, river valleys, and predator territories.

The itinerary begins with Tarangire’s elephants and baobab landscapes before continuing to Central Serengeti and the Western Corridor. The Grumeti River area adds a strong seasonal migration focus, while Ngorongoro Crater completes the route with one of Tanzania’s best wildlife concentrations. With Serengeti Wild Tours, this 6 Days Western Corridor Great Migration Safari in Tanzania offers a balanced private safari for migration viewing, big cats, landscapes, and classic northern Tanzania wildlife.

Day 1

Arrival in Arusha

Meals: Dinner | Accommodation: Arusha lodge or hotel

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport or Arusha Airport, where your Serengeti Wild Tours representative will welcome you and transfer you to your hotel in Arusha. Depending on your arrival time, you may relax at the hotel or meet your guide for a short briefing about the 6 Days Western Corridor Great Migration Safari. Dinner and overnight will be in Arusha.

Arusha to Tarangire National Park

Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Tarangire or Karatu lodge

After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park for your first game drive. Tarangire is known for large elephant herds, ancient baobab trees, seasonal swamps, and classic savannah scenery.

During the game drive, look for elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, buffalo, lions, and many bird species. Later, continue to your lodge or camp for dinner and overnight.

Tarangire to Central Serengeti

Day 3

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Central Serengeti tented camp or lodge

After breakfast, travel toward Serengeti National Park through the Ngorongoro highlands and wide open landscapes. After entering the Serengeti, enjoy an en-route game drive in Central Serengeti.

This area is excellent for lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, gazelles, hyenas, and other resident wildlife. Arrive at your Serengeti camp or lodge for dinner and overnight.

Central Serengeti to Western Corridor and Grumeti River

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Western Serengeti tented camp or lodge

After breakfast, drive west toward the Western Corridor and Grumeti River region. This route offers game viewing across changing Serengeti habitats, including open plains, river valleys, woodlands, and seasonal migration areas. During the Western Corridor migration season, large wildebeest and zebra herds may move through the area. Enjoy game drives while looking for migration herds, crocodiles near river habitats, lions, leopards, elephants, giraffes, buffalo, and plains wildlife.

Western Serengeti Game Drive to Ngorongoro Area

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu lodge

Enjoy a morning game drive in the Western Serengeti and Grumeti River area for another chance to see migration movement and resident wildlife. After lunch, begin the journey back across the Serengeti toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The day combines scenic travel with wildlife viewing as the landscape changes from western plains and river valleys to the crater highlands.

Arrive near Ngorongoro or Karatu for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 **Ngorongoro Crater Game Drive and Return to Arusha**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: No accommodation included

After early breakfast, descend into Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive on the crater floor. This natural wildlife sanctuary offers strong chances to see lions, elephants, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, hyenas, and, with luck, black rhino. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater before ascending the crater wall and driving back to Arusha. This marks the end of your 6 Days Western Corridor Great Migration Safari in Tanzania.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the best time for the 6 Days Western Corridor Great Migration Safari?

The best time is usually from May to July, when Great Migration herds often move through the Western Serengeti and Grumeti River region.

Does this safari include Tarangire and Serengeti?

Yes. This safari includes Tarangire National Park, Central Serengeti, Western Serengeti, the Grumeti River area, and Ngorongoro Crater.

Can I see Grumeti River migration crossings?

The itinerary is designed around the Western Corridor migration season, but river crossings are natural events and cannot be guaranteed. Sightings depend on rainfall, herd movement, and timing.

Is this safari good for big cats?

Yes. Central and Western Serengeti offer strong chances to see lions, leopards, cheetahs, and hyenas, especially where prey animals are concentrated.

Can the safari accommodation be upgraded?
