#### Stop 1: Pick-up and Drive to the Maasai Village

### Stop 2: Maasai Village Walk and Local Life

Begin a guided village walk where you will learn about Maasai homes, livestock, family structure, daily routines, and the role of cattle in Maasai culture. Your hosts will explain how the community lives, how traditions are passed between generations, and how people adapt to the changing environment while keeping important cultural values.

### Stop 3: Traditions, Beadwork, Songs, and Storytelling
