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Overview

This 2 Days 1 Night Ol Doinyo Lengai trek is a short adventure from Moshi to one of Tanzania's most distinctive volcanoes. Ol Doinyo Lengai is located near Lake Natron in the eastern branch of the East African Rift Valley and is known by the Maasai as the Mountain of God. The volcano is famous for its rare natrocarbonatite lava and its dramatic volcanic scenery.

With Serengeti Wild Tours, the trip includes transport, accommodation, meals, required fees, and time to rest before the early summit hike. The highlight is the early morning climb to the summit, where hikers aim to reach the top in time for sunrise before descending and exploring the surrounding area.

Day 1

Moshi to Ol Doinyo Lengai

Meals: Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: African Safari Lodge

Depart from Moshi in the morning and travel toward Ol Doinyo Lengai, the sacred Maasai Mountain of God. The journey takes you into the Rift Valley region near Lake Natron, with changing landscapes and volcanic scenery along the way. Arrive in the afternoon, check into your accommodation, and spend the evening resting, preparing for the early hike, and enjoying the peaceful surroundings.

Hiking Ol Doinyo Lengai

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: Heritage Tented Camp near Tarangire

Start very early for the hike to the summit of Ol Doinyo Lengai, timed to enjoy sunrise views from the volcano. After reaching the summit area, descend in the late morning and continue exploring the surrounding landscape. In the afternoon, relax or join local activities depending on time and arrangements. The evening is used to reflect on the adventure and enjoy the quiet atmosphere

before the trip ends or continues according to the confirmed plan.
