Itinerary

Day 1: Arusha to Serengeti National Park

Day 1

Meals: Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti public campsite or budget camping accommodation

Depart from Arusha in the morning and drive toward Serengeti National Park, passing through the northern Tanzania highlands and conservation landscapes. Arrive in Serengeti and enjoy an afternoon game drive across the open plains, where wildlife sightings may include lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, wildebeest, gazelles, and other animals depending on the season. Dinner and

overnight at a campsite in or near Serengeti.

Day 2: Serengeti Game Drive to Ngorongoro Area

Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro or Karatu area public campsite

Start the day with a game drive in Serengeti National Park, exploring wildlife-rich areas of the plains. After lunch and more game viewing, drive toward the Ngorongoro area for dinner and overnight. This day gives you more time in Serengeti while positioning the group for the crater visit the following morning.

Day 3: Ngorongoro Crater Game Drive and Return to Arusha

Day 3

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Accommodation: No accommodation included

After breakfast, descend into Ngorongoro Crater for a shared game drive. The crater is one of Tanzania's best wildlife viewing areas, with chances to see lions, elephants, buffalo, zebras, wildebeest, hippos, and many bird species. After the game drive, return to Arusha, marking the end of your 3 Day Serengeti and Ngorongoro Joining Safari.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the price based on camping or lodging?

The published package price is based on the camping option per person. A lodging upgrade can be arranged at an additional cost depending on availability and travel dates.

What does joining safari mean?

A joining safari is a shared group safari where travelers join other guests on the same itinerary. It is a good option for travelers who want to reduce safari costs while still visiting Tanzania's major northern circuit parks.

Are park fees included?

Yes. Park entry fees for the parks listed in the itinerary are included unless stated otherwise in the final booking confirmation.

What should I bring for a camping safari?

Bring comfortable safari clothes, warm layers for cool evenings, personal toiletries, sunscreen, hat, camera, power bank, and personal medication.

Can I upgrade from camping to lodging?

Yes. Lodging upgrades are available on request and depend on lodge availability, season, and the final group arrangement.
